



MAGALIES MOUNTAIN VIEW COTTAGE

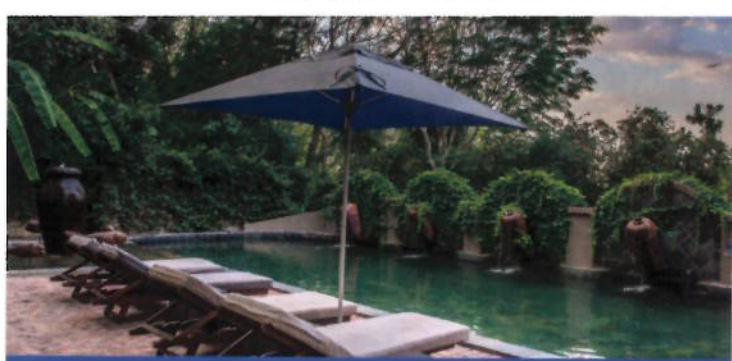
